If outside Lagos state it is NGN 200000 per TEU (except reefer). Reefer: NGN 250000 per TEU if container delivery is within Lagos state. If outside Lagos state (not allowed unless prior agreements between consignee and local agents) it is NGN 500000 per TEU.
