Dangerous goods (import/export) must be under direct delivery. Vessel cannot berth if importer has no required authorization to remove the cargo immediately upon discharge.

Importer must contact the relevant local administrations (Port security, military office, fire office) to assist the delivery from the discharge to the factory

Clauses :

Consolidated containers :

Consolidated containers are not allowed to stuff DG of category 1

Consolidated containers can be stuffed with both DG of category 2 and category 3. Stripping must be done under the port site and under the assistance of Port Security.

Transit on board

Any DG container on board for any category is allowed Subject that safety under Captain care and liability. Those containers must not move during the call.

Shifting during the Pointe Noire call :

Shifting for category 1 containers in transit is forbidden except special authorization from Port Authority after Shipping line request. Under the liability of the stevedore.

Shifting for category 2 and 3 in transit is allowed after shipping line request.

Transshipment cargo

Transshipment of DG of category 1 is allowed as far as both mother vessel and connecting vessel are alongside at the same time.

Storage of transshipment cargo (category 2 and 3) cannot exceed 15 days in the terminal

<u>Class 7</u>

Class 7 (import/export/in transit/in transshipment) must be officially granted by Congolese Administration before loading. We highly recommend to not load any class 7 in our vessels calling Pointe Noire port.
