

ICS2 update: HL New Shipping Instructions


Thank you for using our services.

We are pleased to inform you that our Web SI form, [New SI], has been updated as part of efforts to enhance compliance with the EU security regulation, ICS2 (Import Control System 2).

Key Updates

The new [New SI] form includes additional fields required under ICS2, designed to support smooth customs clearance for shipments to the EU. Please follow the steps below to use the updated form:

- 1. Log in to the Shipping Instructions section on our website.
- 2. Select the relevant shipment number.
- 3. Click the "Use New SI to Submit" button.
- 4. If the shipment is subject to ICS2 requirements, the **Customs Requirements** section will appear under item 3 of the input screen.



Depending on your selected options, additional fields may appear for you to provide the required information. For details, please refer to **Case 1) to 5)**.

Request for Usage

We kindly request that you use our updated [New SI] form for all future shipments. Please note that if you submit your SI using [New SI], it is no longer necessary to transmit ACL via NACCS.

Required Information

For shipments subject to ICS2, the following details must be provided:

4 6-digit HS code and accurate goods description (You can input this information in Cargo Description field instead of Customs Requirements filed)

- CUS code for harmless or hazardous chemicals (if listed in ECICS/European Customs Inventory of Chemical Substances)
- ♣ UCR number (if available)
- Consignee's EORI number or complete address details (including P.O. Box, postal code, city, and country)
- **♦** EORI number of the House BL Self-Filer and/or Buyer/Seller information

Additional Information (Effective December)

If you request us to file on your behalf, the following additional details will also be required:

- Buyer and Seller information (mandatory for all shipments to the EU)
- House BL data (required under specific conditions)

Important Notes

For bookings marked with "EU Customs" in the Booking Confirmation, it is crucial to submit accurate and complete Shipping Instructions by the stated deadline. Failure to meet the deadline may result in the shipment being subject to the EU's "No MRN / No Load" rule, meaning the cargo cannot be loaded.

Please also note that ICS2 applies not only to imports but also to EU-origin goods loaded onto vessels that call at non-EU ports.



Case 1) [F10: Straight BL +Seller and Buyer filing by HL]



Case 2) [F13: Straight BL filing by HL without SE/BU]


Please select: I am the cargo owner, File seller and buyer data through self filing / supplementary declarant Please fill the boxes.



Case3) [F12: Only Master BL filing without Seller and Buyer by HL]


Please select: I am a self filer / filing by supplementary declarant




Case 4) [F11: Master BL, incl. Seller and Buyer, and all house BLs filing by HL]
